Corney & Barrow Sparkling Blanc de Blancs Méthode Traditionnelle NV

Made in the prestigious “traditional method” of champagne, this affordable sparkling wine impresses with its soft texture and aromatic freshness.

Blended for us by our long-time partner, the renowned Boisset family, this Sparkling Blanc de Blancs is a big favourite at Corney & Barrow. Located in the heart of the prestigious town of Nuits-Saint-Georges in Burgundy, the Boisset family increasingly moved towards sparkling winemaking throughout the '90s and today rely on long-term partnerships with growers across France's most prized appellations. This wine is what we call a “traditional method” as it follows the process made famous by the Champagne region, where a secondary fermentation takes place in the bottle – the crucial moment when the delicate bubbles are born. The wine is left in contact with its fine lees for 12 months to gain aromatic and textural complexity.

A blend of Ugni Blanc, Colombard, Chardonnay, Chenin Blanc and Jacquère grapes

Fragrant and refreshing, this traditional method sparkling wine boasts delicate white blossom, ripe orchard fruit and a hint of brioche on the finish. Carefully aged on its lees for 12 months in Boisset's cellars, it has gained aromatic and textural complexity. Gently creamy with a fine mousse – simply irresistible!

Corney & Barrow White Burgundy Maison Auvigue 2018

A bespoke blend from high quality vineyards, this is a gently creamy and flavoursome introduction to Burgundian Chardonnay.

Home to some of the world's most regal chardonnays, Burgundy can also produce wines at a more affordable price tag. From the southern region of the Mâconnais, this Mâcon-Villages from Maison Auvigue is a delicious introduction to Burgundian Chardonnay. The family's long history of winemaking in the Mâconnais, own vineyard holdings and long-standing partnerships with some of the best local growers, ensures ongoing supply of grapes from high-quality vineyards. Today, Maison Auvigue is run by Sylvain Brenas-Auvigue and his talented team, whose philosophy is that if you let nature do the work, it allows the specific terroirs to express themselves through the wines. This white Burgundy is blended to our specification by our very own buying team in partnership with Sylvain and winemaker Céline Hirsch. Using grapes from a mix of young and more mature vines, it showcases the orchard fruit aromas so classic to Chardonnay, with lovely weight and texture on the palate.

Corney & Barrow Rosé, IGP Comté Tolosan 2019

A juicy and succulent rosé with the hallmark freshness of the Pyrénées, made exclusively for us by Plaimont, our partner for thirty years.

Our C&B Rosé is a moreish blend of beautifully ripened Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, planted in the foothills of the Pyrénées range. There, the vines benefit from a long and warm ripening season tempered by cool breezes which enhance aromatic freshness and give a bright colour. Grown sustainably, the berries are carefully harvested and the wine tailored to a secret recipe defined by Plaimont's chief winemaker, Christine Cabri, together with C&B's buying team.

Our own, very special blend. Juicy, fruity and supple. A real crowd-pleaser.

The grapes for our Corney & Barrow House Red are grown in the heart of the Languedoc region. Here, the Mediterranean sun gives them the ripeness that translates into a fruity, juicy wine, whilst the soil and sea breezes impart finesse and freshness. Each year, our buying team travel to the south of France to collaborate with our long-standing partner, Celliers Jean d'Alibert to work on this unique wine. It is a blend of old-vine Carignan with a dash of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre, so expect warmth, a supple texture and lots of red fruit, with a touch of spice.

Corney & Barrow Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Zugober 2016

A classically structured Rioja Crianza, made in the highly-reputed Rioja Alavesa area by a small, terroir-driven family winery, Bodegas Zugober.

Bodegas Zugober winery was established in 1987, in the heart of the renowned Rioja Alavesa area, by viticulturist Eduardo Gomez Palma and his winemaker wife Maribel Bernardo. Having embraced their respective families winemaking heritage at a young age, they set up the winery of their dreams and have now been joined by their son Manuel. Located on the edge of the Sierra de Cantabria mountains, over rich limestone soils, the family creates characterful wines which combine a classic Rioja structure, underlying freshness and a pure fruit expression.

Aged for fourteen months in American oak, with additional time in the bottle, this elegant wine combines juicy plum and ripe cherry characters, savoury spice, soft tannins and a mineral finish true to the region.

Richness, structure and a dash of hedonism are the aims here. No ageing required, this is succulent and approachable from the off.

Maison Sichel is a much-respected family company ticking most boxes - Château owner, producer and *négociant* house. Sichel has amassed more than 125 years of experience. The Corney & Barrow buying team, helped by Sichel's Technical Director, Yvan Meyer, blended this claret. There's no denying the combined experience nor Corney & Barrow's predilection for a Merlot-rich style, even here in the Cabernet sanctuary of Sichel. Why Merlot? Its fleshy, rounded style offers the vinous equivalent of a warm, comfy slipper – the Cabernet Sauvignon element adding focus.

Whilst the C&B claret is a rather outstanding gentleman of a wine, the company reserve has something of a twinkle in its eye - almost too drinkable. Plum-ruby in colour, it offers a combination of red and black fruit, combined with earthy notes and a touch of vanilla. Generous fruit on the palate is complemented by ripe tannins. Warrants a leisurely meal, the wine developing further aromatics in the glass.
