ROSÉ MIXED CASE

Rosé wines come in varying styles and many hues, from an ethereal blush to a deep salmon pink. They are wonderful thirst-quenchers, but also offer just as much intrigue and food pairing power as whites or reds. Explore the world through rosé tinted glasses with this mixed case of crisp, refreshing, summery wines.

Sancerre Rosé 2017, Domaine de la Grande Maison Chaumeau-Balland – Loire

From the rolling hills of Sancerre, this enticing Pinot Noir rosé is made in small quantities by the Chaumeau family.

Renowned for its Sauvignon Blanc, the Loire Valley can also produce some very pretty rosé wines made from the Pinot Noir grape. In the Loire's far eastern corner, about two hundred kilometres south of Paris, lies the famous appellation of Sancerre. Away from the influence of the ocean, the seasons are more defined and the summers much warmer, enabling Pinot Noir to grow. The family-run domaine of La Grande Maison Chaumeau-Balland stretches over the rolling hills surrounding the village of Bué, just down the road from Sancerre. The land was converted from farming to viticulture in 1983 by Pierre Chaumeau. Today, his daughter-in-law Sylvie runs it with her son Alex and daughter Anaïs, both recent oenology graduates. This being Sancerre, they specialise in growing Sauvignon Blanc, but also tend three hectares of Pinot Noir vines. By gently pressing the Pinot Noir grapes, Sylvie controls how long the skins are in contact with the wine, which produces a delicate pink hue and adds some subtle structure from the tannins. The unique fossil-rich, stony soils give the wine a flinty mineral aroma and a delicious fruit intensity.

A perfect rosé for the summer. Delicate salmon pink colour and an enticing nose of strawberries and cream. The palate is floral, soft, with a crunchy texture from the tannins and refreshing acidity. With a little bottle age, this wine shows succulent macerated red berries and white peach.

Petit Ballon Rosé, IGP Comté Tolosan, Plaimont 2018 – Gascony

A juicy and succulent rosé with the hallmark freshness of the Pyrénées, made exclusively for us by Plaimont, our partner for thirty years.

Petit Ballon Rosé is a moreish blend of beautifully ripened Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, planted in the foothills of the Pyrénées range. There, the vines benefit from a long and warm ripening season tempered by cool breezes which enhance aromatic freshness and give a bright colour. Grown sustainably, the berries are carefully harvested and the wine tailored to a secret recipe defined by Plaimont's chief winemaker, Christine Cabri, together with C&B's buying team.

Source Gabriel Rosé 2019 – AOC Côtes de Provence

This is classic Provence rosé. So pale and delicate, yet fruity. Floral notes coupled with that kind of rich stone fruit you only get from wines from this part of France. A summer staple.

This wine is effectively a joint project between Régine Sumeire and her nephew Roger Blanc Sumeire. Régine was one of the first women winemakers in the region and an early pioneer of the famous pale Provence style. Source Gabriel Rosé is dedicated to Gabriel Sumeire, Roger's great-grandfather and Régine's grandfather, whose work in the vineyards and cellar alike were to set the benchmark for future generations. The wine is made from grapes at the ten-hectare Domaine de Font-Freye just across the road from Château La Tour de L'Evêque and its name references the legend of the local spring, the 'source Gabriel' as it is now known. As the legend goes, when the Lord of the estate left for the crusades many centuries ago, his wife was so distraught that her tears poisoned the fountain and caused it to dry up completely. It was not until the twentieth century that the visionary Gabriel Sumeire, a talented engineer, put an end to this curse by finding a way to link the fountain to the nearby 'source' (spring) of Font-Freye.

A classic pale and delicate Provence rosé. Soft and moreish with its creamy red berry flavours and gentle floral notes, it has some zesty citrus with a hint of richer stone fruit too.

Rosé, Nelson Family Vineyards 2019 - Paarl

A garden party in a glass! The perfect rosé for the summer – succulent, refreshing and delicious

Nelson Estate is a family wine farm in every sense of the word. Restoring an old farm into a leading winery was a childhood dream for founder Alan Nelson and today his daughter Lisha is its talented winemaker. Lisha was recently awarded the status of Cape Wine Master, the most sought-after, prestigious accolade of the South African wine industry. This is no small feat if you consider there are only around a hundred in the whole country! Situated in the Paarl region, on the seaward side of its namesake mountain, the vineyards benefit from close proximity to the Atlantic Ocean, with its cooling night breezes and misty mornings. These are responsible for the trademark freshness found in all Nelson wines. Lisha continues to grow the reputation of this magnificent family estate and diligently ensures that the utmost care goes into producing every bottle of these award winning wines. To make this Rosé, the juice of the grapes is briefly left to rest on the skins to impart a delicate colour and flavour to the wine. Each grape variety is then fermented separately in stainless steel tanks and then blended together to achieve the perfect balance.

85% Petit Verdot, 10% Cabernet Franc and 5% Shiraz

An unusual blend of Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc and Shiraz, this wine has a delicate pink colour, and an enticing, perfumed nose. The palate is expressive and pretty, balancing succulent red berries and a swirl of cream.

Sanziana Pinot Grigio Rosé, Recas Cramele 2018 – Banat

A fresh and floral rosé, packed with red berry fruit, made in one of the oldest vineyard areas in the world

Recas Cramele is a Romanian/British company privately owned and run by a team of three families, one of which has been working the Recas vineyards for over 40 years. Together, they have bought up and restored vineyards left derelict as a result of the communist regime and built one of the largest wineries in Eastern Europe.

The families have sought expertise from around the world, hiring veteran winemakers from Australia and Spain, along with viticulturists from Italy. Together, their experience and training have transformed Recas Cramele into one of the most important wine producers in Romania, creating a bright, pristine and fresh style of wine. Their continuous dedication to improving quality has put them at the forefront of the Romanian wine renaissance and called attention to the great wines being produced all over Eastern Europe.

Marsannay Rosé Domaine Joseph Roty 2016 – Burgundy

A Pinot Noir rosé with Burgundian complexity – structured, stylish, with potential to age.

Marsannay is a special place. The northernmost wine village in the Côte de Nuits in Burgundy, it is the only village-level appellation allowed to produce a rosé under its appellation name. As one of the coolest villages in the Côte, Marsannay produces wines that are fine and linear, with a fresh zip. With a mix of limestone, granite and clay soils, the rosé wines have an energetic minerality, with a slight savoury character. When the Roty family first invested in Marsannay, eyebrows were raised as vineyards were then being sacrificed to increasing urban sprawl, but the family's prescience, so many decades ago, preceded a strong interest in the area.

Roty Marsannay rosé is the produce of fifty year old Pinot Noir vines. It is made using direct pressing - just two hours under light pressure to extract aromatics and colour. With eighteen months' ageing in old oak, the wine has weight and complexity. It is a serious wine, more suited to white linen and candelabra than quaffing alongside a pool. A tremendous foil for classic dishes as well as more exotic meanderings into the realm of spice.

The 2016 vintage is stylish and direct, bristling with redcurrant and cassis energy, with hints of lavender and wild herbs. Embellished by exotic fruits – grapefruit, mango – it is hard not to smile.
